Congratulations to **James Yeash, D.O.** who delivered his 1,000th baby on May 26, 2006 at Avista Adventist Hospital in Louisville. Doctor Yeash has delivered babies as a

family physician for more than 20 years and has literally delivered babies all over the world since assisting on his first delivery as a medical student. "I knew this was clearly one of the most rewarding things you can do," Yeash told the *Daily Camera*. He attended the Philadelphia College of Osteopathic Medicine in 1982 and completed his family medicine residency at Silas B. Hay Army Community Hospital. Yeash served 22 years in the U.S. Army, where he delivered babies while stationed at NATO's post in Belgium.
